Law Student membership runs on a modified school-year calendar (September through August) and the application is renewable annually. TPCBA dues are waived for Law Students as described as any person who is enrolled in an ABA or Washington State Bar accredited law school as a candidate for a juris doctor degree.

Law students who complete the membership application will be eligible to serve on the TPCBA Young Lawyers Section and attend their monthly meetings. (A Young Lawyer is a lawyer 36 years of age or younger, or who have practiced law for five years or less). The TPCBA-YLS sponsors a number of social events, which give students and new lawyers a chance to meet and socialize with their friends and colleagues in the Tacoma area.
